Rationale: Caring for material needs is a means to sharing the gospel, meeting spiritual needs. However, every relationship ought to be reciprocal. Relationships based on charity are pathological (Lupton). Both parties ought to give and receive. We all experience poverty of some kind, whether that's material, spiritual, or relational, etc. (see *When Helping Hurts*). So, we do not enter into a situation of need as the savior. There is one Savior, Jesus Christ. We enter into need with a posture of humility, recognizing that we have needs that this divine encounter is meant to meet. That may be slowing down to see someone else's humanity. That may be asking the person to pray for you. Further, we recognize that isolated acts are products of unjust systems. The systems of our society were built on white supremacy and meritocracy. Therefore, we engage unjust systems, as well as individual acts of mercy and justice. Sometimes this looks like mentoring a youth from the neighborhood. Other times it is attending a court hearing as an advocate. Other times it is clearing a past debt so that an individual's credit can be cleared, enabling them to acquire affordable housing. Whatever it may be, we engage people and systems so that our communities can flourish. That is the end goal. We empower, not enable, one another. We give hand-ups, not handouts.
